Dear Parents and Guardians,

As part of the **Truth or Consequences** expedition, Windsor 8 students will be engaged in field work at The Holocaust and Human Rights Center of Maine. The Center is at the University of Maine-Augusta campus.

The event is TUESDAY, MAY 30 during the school day. Students will leave King at 9:00 a.m. and return to school at 2:00 p.m.

Students will rotate through two workshops. They will explore how propaganda affects us. By looking at both historical images from Nazi Germany and modern advertising, students will learn how stereotypes are reinforced. Students will also explore how ordinary people participated in crimes during the Nazi Holocaust.

These workshops will connect students to the guiding questions of our expedition:

- *What is the truth?
- *How and why do people manipulate the truth?
- *Who can you trust?
